



RBR.LV "SPRING CUP" 2020 Regulation

1. General info

- 1.1 RBR.LV championship are available only for Baltic drivers.
- 1.2 Championship will be conducted on platform **Richard Burns Rally**, using CZ plugin and NGP6 newest physics.
- 1.3 Information about the championship are published on the website **RBR.LV**, our **Facebook page** and **forum** or direct inquires to the organizer, please contact via private message on the FB fan page, contact form on the website or directly on our e-mail info@rbr.lv
- 1.4 **RBR.LV License is required** to participate in Spring Cup. License can obtain- <https://www.rbr.lv/rbrlv-lice/>

2. Championship info

- 2.1 At each event will be maximum **7** stages with a total distance no more than **40km**.
- 2.2 Championship will consist of 4 rallies.
- 2.3 Each event starts at 08:00 Wednesday and ends on Sunday 23:59
- 2.4 Before every event will be Official test stage (Shakedown). Start at Sunday 08:00 and ends on Tuesday 23:59.
- 2.5 **Spring Cup calendar:**
 1. event – 11.03 – 16.03.2020
 2. event - 25.03 – 30.03.2020
 3. event - 08.04 – 13.04.2020
 4. event - 22.04 - 27.04.2020
- 2.6 The administration reserves the right to change the calendar, or parts unilaterally. But should inform at least 3 days before the start of the rally

3. Requests

- 3.1 If the status of the driver shows "DNF", request will be rejected..
- 3.2 If the status of the driver is "DNS" or there isn't a status, request will be approved

4. Cars

- 4.1 Cars are divided to three classes:
 - **4WD (R4, N4)**
 - Mitsubishi Lancer EVO IX N4
 - Subaru Impreza N14 N4
 - Mitsubishi Lancer EVO IX R4
 - Mitsubishi Lancer EVO X R4
 - Subaru Impreza N15 R4
 - **2WD (R2),**
 - Citreon C2 R2 Max
 - Ford Fiesta Mk VIII R2
 - Ford Fiesta R2
 - Opel Adam R2
 - Peugeot 206 R2
 - Renault Twingo R2 Evo

4.2 Car can be changed **one** time during the season.

5. Point system

5.1 Season standings for the Cup are determined by adding up the points earned in all events taking place during the season. Higher place is given to the crews with more points

5.2 Points are allocated to the top ten drivers in each competition on a 15-12-10-8-6-5-4-3-2-1 basis.

6. Fair play

6.1. The organization has the rights of asking a replay within 24 hours since the event has finished via Personal Message in the Czech Plugin page. The driver has 48 hours since he receives the message to upload the replay in the "Send Replay" part of the Czech Plugin. Sending via e-mail won't be considered. (+6 minutes for every not sent replay).

6.2. One wheel must always touch the road (+10 seconds for every cut).

6.3. Is not allowed to have an object between the car and the road (+30 seconds each).

6.4. The driver has the right to protest, if he/she considers that the penalty applied by the plugin is unfair. Protest must be supported with replay uploaded on the RBR CZ server. Drivers can submit protests writed to us info@rbr.lv

6.5. Starting with 2 or more accounts: DQ

7. Additional information

7.1 We encourage to all drivers to send us your photos, onboard or highlight videos of the rally so that we could publish a gallery after each rally. info@rbr.lv

7.2 Each driver must have his name in this style: NAME Surname or SURNAME Name.

7.3 The organizer reserves the option to change all the circumstances of the championship at any time.
